Northern Division Commander Assumes Charge of Department of Misseuri.

PERMANENT SUCCESSOR FIRST OF YEAR

Personal Aides-de-Camp of Wint at Havana Will Be Lieutenants Allen and Davis Who Will Accompany Him.

Orders were received at headquarters, Department of the Missouri, Monday mornng announcing that Major General A. W. Greely, commanding the Northern Military division, will assume command of the Department of the Missouri December 1, relleving Brigadier General T. J. Wint, who is under orders to proceed to Cuba to take mand of the American troops on that island. This is a confirmation of The Bue's story Monday morning.

General Wint will leave Omaha December 5 or 6 for Washington for further instructions and is due to arrive in Cuba December 15. He will make his headquarters at Havana, His personal aides-decomp. Licutenents Allen and Davis, will ompany him to Cuba. There will be no material change in the personnel of the official or clerical force of the army headquarters, other then in the departure of Seneral Wint and his alder. The announcement of a permanent com

mander for the Department of the Misseuri will not be made until about the first of tille press:
