GREELY-TAKES WINT'S WORK

Northern Division Commander Assumes Charge of Department of Missouri.

PERMANENT SUCCESSOR FIRST OF YEAR

Personal Aide-de-Camp of Wint at Havana Will Be Lieutenant Allen and Davis Who Will Accompany Him.

Orders were received at headquarters, Department of the Missouri, Monday morning announcing that Major General A. W. Greely, commanding the Northern Military Division, will assume command of the Department of the Missouri December 1, relieving Brigadier General T. J. Wint, who is under orders to proceed to Cuba to take command of the American troops on that island. This is a confirmation of The Bee's story Monday morning.

General Wint will leave Omaha December 5 or 8 for Washington for further instructions and is due to arrive in Cuba December 15. He will make his headquarters at Havana. His personal aide-de-camp, Lieutenants Allen and Davis, will accompany him to Cuba. There will be no material change in the personnel of the official or clerical force of the army headquarters, other than in the departure of General Wint and his aides.

The announcement of a permanent commander for the Department of the Missouri will not be made until about the first of the year.

Major General A. W. Greely will exercise the dual command of the Northern Military Division and that of the Department of the Missouri, alternating between Chicago and Omaha, as the emergency may require.
