New Burlington Branch Will Give Omaha Greater Fuel Resources.

TO RUN FROM WORLAND TO GEBO

Official Announcement is Made of This Extension and Reports of Others are in Circulation.

Before another winter Omaha will have another coal mine on the Burlington railroad to help relieve the coal situation. The Burlington is officially announced that the Burlington will build a line twenty-five miles in length from Worland to Gebu, where a good quality of lignite coal, similar to the Sheridan coal, has been found in large quantities.

A superintendent will be appointed for the Omaha division, with offices in Omaha.
