WHY BOX RENTS ARE RAISED

Palmer Says Government Wishes to Encourage Carrier Delivery System. "One of the reasons for the big increase in the rental price of postoffice boxes that has just gone into effect, says Postmaster Palmer, is to adjust the rates more equitably. In all the larger cities the box rentals have been increased even to a greater extent than in Omaha. These boxes occupy a great deal of space that could be used for more convenient purposes for the public. Hence the government wishes to encourage the carrier delivery system for the sole purpose of its greater convenience to the public and the more expeditious delivery of the mails.

"While on the postoffice subject I wish it were possible to educate the public up to the knowledge of the advantages of the substitution of postoffices, particularly here in Omaha. We have, as you know, four of these substations; one at Fortieth and Cumming, one at Lake and Twenty-fourth streets, one on Twenty-ninth and Leavenworth streets. Admitting that these substations are a convenience on Sundays, they certainly are not so on week days. By doing away with them it would call in thirty additional carriers to the main office, and carrier deliveries could be made more promptly by thus increasing the general force, and would be an saving of \$150 monthly expense in rentals and other incidentals. In many cases as much as twelve hours could be saved in the delivery of mail, which might be very important to the recipient. In the main downtown office the mail is sent out in a very short time after its arrival, whereas in the case of the substations the mail is to be handled twice before it reaches the recipient and may have to lay in the substitution office twelve hours or more before delivery."

PRAYER OF HIS CHILDHOOD

Incident Related of Charles E. Morgan as He Underwent Operation at Chicago. In his eulogy upon the life of the late Charles E. Morgan at Calvary Baptist church Tuesday, Rev. F. Fellman told a pathetic incident illustrative of the Christian character and hopefulness of Mr. Morgan. The story was to the effect that when Mr. Morgan went to Chicago some months ago to undergo a surgical operation with the hope of benefiting him in the ailment that resulted in his death, Mr. Morgan asked that he be permitted to offer up a prayer before the anesthetic was administered. The surgeons stood beside him with uncovered heads as he lay on the operating table and heard the patient say: "It do not doubt that I shall recover from this operation, but I feel as though I would like just now to repeat that little prayer that our mothers have taught us. 'Now I lay me down to sleep.'"

He calmly offered the prayer, and, notwithstanding it turned out the surgeons said: "Now I am ready." The operation was successful, but the disease was too far advanced for the operation to afford him anything more than a temporary relief.
