Ralph Kitchen Secures Paxton Hotel Stock and with George E.

Pritchett Will Administer the Estate.

The will of the late James B. Kitchen was filed in the county court yesterday. In it he makes provision for five young women, cashiers at the Paxton hotel, as long as they shall remain unmarried. The other beneficiaries are his wife, Josephine Kitchen, Richard Kitchen, Ralph Kitchen and M. Stanley Connell. Ralph Kitchen and George E. Pritchett are named as executors. The will is dated December 14, 1906. No inventory of property has been filed, but it is said to consist of \$150,000 real and \$150,000 personal. To his nephew, Ralph Kitchen, he leaves 297 shares of the capital stock of the Kitchen Bros. Hotel company in trust, he to receive the income until January 1, 1920, and then transfer the shares to his son, Richard Kitchen. If the latter is not living they are to go to M. Stanley Connell. half of lot 6, block 138, which is a building on Harney street between Fourteenth and Of Omaha, organized in 1863. Fifteenth streets. He states he wishes to provide a home for five unmarried women, Jennie Fagerberg, and for this purpose he leaves lot "C," Kellom's First addition, to Mary and Katie Fagerberg. If either marries or dies it is to go to the other, and if both marry or die it is to go to the other three sisters. This property is located at 112 South Twenty-fourth street and is the home of the girls to whom it is bequeathed by Mr. Kitchen. Three of the girls are now cashiers at the Paxton hotel.

To Richard Kitchen is left the east onethird of lot 3, block 138, which is a building just west of the Paxton hotel. He is to pay the income of this property to the widow of the deceased during her life. On her death one-third of the income is to go to Katle Fagerberg for two years and onethird to Mary Fagerberg for two years. All the rest of the property is left to his
