One Hundred and Sixty-Eight Lots Sold and Will Be Improved.

One hundred and sixty-eight lots in Collier Place and Monmouth Park, just south of Fort Omaha, have been bought by a syndicate headed by Hastings & Heyden, to improve and place on the market next summer. These lots belonged to the estate of George B. Collier, the Philadelphia publisher, represented in the transaction by the Hayes Real Estate Company. The consideration is said to have been in the neighborhood of \$30,000. The property was bought in boom times by Mr. Collier, and when financial depression came taxes were allowed to accumulate. They have been cleaned up under the scavenger law. The syndicate will clear the property of rubbish, lay sewers and sidewalks and build several houses before offering the lots for sale.

Nels Hallenberg has sold his house and lot in Benson for \$2,500 to William O. Talbot, who will make it his home. The Payne Investment company made the transaction.
