

EARNINGS OF UNION PACIFIC

Thirty-Five Million Dollars Net for Current Fiscal Year. TEN PER CENT DIVIDEND WILL NOT BE CUT

Such is the Prediction of High Wall Street Authority with Its Finger on the Financial Pulse. A few days ago The Bee printed figures quoted by high Wall Street authority to show that the Burlington's gross earnings for the current fiscal year at the present ratio would be \$30,000,000.

None Expands as Much. No great railroad in the last fiscal year has expanded its dividend paying capacity to an extent equal to the expansion in dividend paying capacity of the Union Pacific.

Men who are in a position to know say that the idea of a cut in the dividend of the Union Pacific is preposterous and not worthy of notice.

Few people really appreciate the work that is being done in the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific this year.

The present indications are that when the Union Pacific gets down to paying its fixed charges this year it will have exhausted over \$20,000,000, applicable to those charges.

The earnings of the Southern Pacific, however, are a different matter. Over 40 per cent of all the surplus earnings of the Southern Pacific railroad belongs to the Union Pacific road.

Under the present conservative management of the Southern Pacific movement, the effect is to turn the surplus back into the road, yet it could in case of need be turned over to its legitimate owner, the Union Pacific; and thus considering it, it brings the real earnings of the Union Pacific well over 50 per cent on its common stock.
