SALOON CASES ALL GO OVER

Judge Unable to Hear Contempt Proceedings Against Brown at This Time. MAY NOT BE REACHED BEFORE JUNE

As This Must Be Heard Before Saloon Injunctions Are Tried They Await All of Them Hang Up Indefinitely.

The contempt case against J. Brown, the saloon crusader from Kansas, was postponed indefinitely yesterday in district court, and will be one of the injunction suits against saloonkeepers in this city and county.

The postponement was due to the fact that the hearing in the bank check case of Ernest Braunman against the Council Bluffs Savings and the Crawford County State banks was still occupying the attention of the court.

Brown and his attorney, N. A. Crawford, were in court, and the former expressed himself as not at all satisfied with the decision. Mr. Crawford said: "We do not want Mr. Brown held responsible for this delay. We want it understood that if there is any delay the county attorney is responsible for it."

"About when do you think you will be through with the jury cases?" asked Mr. Crawford of the court.

"This is hard to tell at this time. I can tell better about the middle of May. It is probable that the jury will be held until the first of June and the equity cases can be taken up after that. I will continue court as long as it is necessary."
