Market Opened Strong, but Weather Conditions Cause Slight Reaction.

FEATURELESS MARKET EXCEPT IN WHEAT

Wheat Opened Strong and Advanced Slightly, with Later Decline on Reported Showers and Predicted Rain.

OMAHA, April 22, 1907.

Showers in the southwestern wheat belt caused an easier market and little trading was done except wheat. There were reports of a receipt of more damage to crops, but reaction on real realization was.

Wheat was affected by the large receipts in the northwest and a slight increase in the visible supply. Rain was reported in southern Kansas, Missouri and crop reports were of a more conservative character than those received recently.

Reports of frost damage were received from northern Kansas, causing a slight advance in both May and July wheat, but predicted showers and a somewhat able weather forecast caused prices to ease off.

Trading in corn was of small proportions, as receipts from the interior were fairly steady on higher cables, as the export demand at southern ports was lighter.

Primary wheat receipts were 300,000 bushels, against receipts of 250,000 bushels and shipments of 150,000 bushels.

Clearances were 212,000 bushels, against 150,000 bushels last year. Primary wheat receipts were 300,000 bushels, against receipts of 250,000 bushels.

The visible wheat supply increased this week 21,000 bushels to 51,700,000 bushels, against 34,000,000 bushels.
