1937, for the purchase of 100,000 of
20-year option bonds of the city of
York, Nebraska, \$100,000 electric light,
\$5,000 water rights, and \$100,000 of
water rights, authorized by the electors at a special
election held March 28, 1937, by a vote of more
than two-thirds of the qualified electors.
The date of maturity of the bonds shall be
denominated, except five for \$50,000,
and shall be made for the entire
term of such class, and the interest
on the amount of premium offered and that
accrued interest, if any, will be paid up
to and including date of delivery of bonds,
and must be accompanied by a certified
check upon a solvent bank for \$50 upon
the date of maturity of the bonds, and
a certain amount of cash to be held in
trust for the city of York, Nebraska,
as provided by the resolution of the
electors. Bids for less than the
amount of the bonds shall not be
considered. Checks of unaccepted
bidders will not be returned. The right
reserved to reject any and all bids.
Bidders will be held to the amount of their
bids. The city of York, Nebraska,
may, in its discretion, issue bonds of
less than the amount of the bonds

CROSS LINE ON FORTIETH

CROSS LINE ON FORTIETH
Street Car Tracks Will Be Run from
Farnam to Cumine Street.
Half the Number of Farnam Street
Cars Will Be Run to Cumine
and Half to
Dundee.
A cross-town line on Fortieth street has
been decided upon by the Omaha & Council
Bluffs Street Railway company and
work will be begun on the line at once.
The city engineer has authorized the
company to lay the double tracks, which will
run from Fortieth and Dodge streets to
Fortieth and Cumine. A short jog is made
on Fortieth street at Davenport to the
west, and the line will connect with the
Farnam street line at Fortieth and Dodge
streets. When this is completed half
the Farnam street cars will be run to
Fortieth and Cumine streets, where they
will stop, and half will run to Dundee.
Work will be begun at once on the block
between Dodge and Davenport streets, as
this street is to be paved and the directors
wish to install the tracks before the paving
is done.
Work also has been authorized on a new
track from Thirteenth and Davenport
streets west on Davenport to Fifteenth and
north on Fifteenth to Webster streets. This
work is to be done as soon as the numerous
crossings of the railroad tracks which
would be necessary when the Northwestern
builds its tracks to the new freight depot
which is now in course of construction.
Two crossings are now necessary over the
Missouri Pacific tracks and these will be
done away with by the change.
Contracts for New Cables.
James Jensen has been awarded the contract
by the Omaha & Council Bluffs Street
Railway company for the laying of the
conductors to carry the high voltage cables
for transmitting the power from the new
plant to the outlying stations. Power is
to be carried at 12,000 volts and reduced to
550 volts at the converting stations which
will be built. The contract calls for the
construction of conductors from the power
station on the river to Seventeenth and
Farnam streets, and from there to the
outlying stations, including Webster street.
The work is to be done as soon as the
material is expected to arrive for this.
The company also is going to raise the
light rails with heavier ones on the line
to Fairmont park in Council Bluffs. This
work will be done as soon as the heavier
rails, which have been ordered for some
time, arrive.

FLYNN TURNS OVER TOOLS

Flynn Turns Over Tools
Street Commissioner Flynn Monday morning
formally turned over to City Engineer
Rosewater such tools and effects as should
be under the engineer's jurisdiction by virtue
of a recent law establishing the "public
works department" and giving to the
engineer such work as street cleaning,
crossing and gutters, formerly under the
street commissioner. There is now left in
the funds to be turned over by the street
commissioner \$20,000. The street commissioner
will have charge of only street
cleaning.
