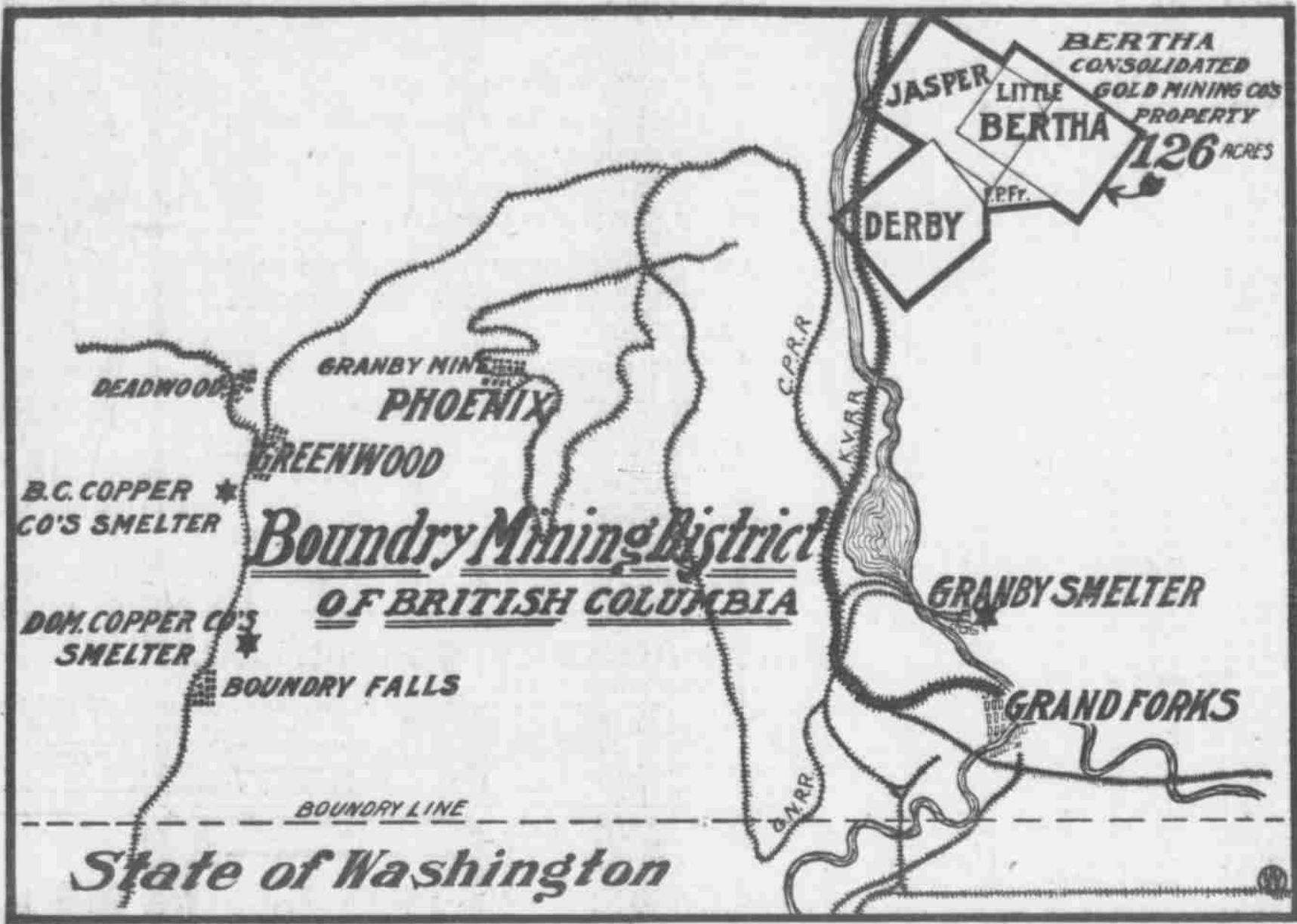

GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET

Large Receipts and Weaker Cables Cause Weakness in Market

CASH MARKET ACTIVE, BUT SOME LOWER

Warmer Conditions Exchange and Freights and Low Temperature Generally Reported Throughout the Winter Wheat Belt.

OMAHA, May 4, 1907.

Large receipts and weaker cables caused depression in the market, although opening prices were steady. Continued unfavorable weather in the winter wheat belt checked the decline and closing prices were only slightly lower. Trading was of light volume and many and important orders in and out were subject to some liquidation. The close was steady, as traders are awaiting the outcome of the present weather conditions.

Wheat opened steady, but some liquidation of the July and September options ensued. Seeding in Kansas is delayed on account of unfavorable weather and farm markets were unimpaired. The weather in the wheat section was generally clear with extremely low temperatures in and out. Change was predicted by the forecast. More big reports were received from Minnesota and Kansas, but in other reports the crop situation was unchanged. Broome had estimated the world's shipments at 1,300,000 bushels and Australian shipments for the week were 62,000 bushels, as compared with 60,000 bushels last week. India shipments were 25,000 bushels, against 23,000 bushels last week and 410,000 bushels for the year. May wheat closed steady at the opening figures. Rice asked, and July and September options closed with a decline of 1/4c. Demand for corn was light and the market sagged after a heavy opening, although there was good buying of September options. The primary movement is moderate and is expected to continue so. The close was weak, with declines of 1/4c in each option.

Crop news on oats was bullish, but all options suffered a loss of 1/4c on trading of light volume. The demand was moderate and the general situation firm. The cash market was active, but at lower prices, with good demand for the better grades.

Primary wheat receipts were 48,000 bu. and shipments 49,000 bu., against receipts last year of 41,000 bu. and shipments of 22,000 bu. Corn receipts were 21,000 bu., and shipments were 15,000 bu., against receipts last year of 21,000 bu., and shipments of 12,000 bu.

Clearances were 1,500 bu. wheat, 21,000 bu. corn, 1,400 bu. oats, and wheat and flour equal to 22,000 bu.

Levelled coal unchanged to bid lower on wheat, but unchanged in bid higher on corn.
