New York Central Rises Slightly on Report of Increased Net Earnings for Month of April.

NEW YORK, May 8.—Operations in the stock market were at a minimum today and the feeble and uncertain fluctuations in prices were the result of a lack of conviction on the part of speculators.

The dealings were in the hands of a narrow professional class and did not tend to represent anything more than shifting and efforts to find a prevailing market.

On the side of the crop news stock fell better than for several days past. Great importance was attached to the average yield in the northwest as being a promise of opportunity to effect the planting of spring wheat.
