

LINCOLN GETS THE LAST ONE

Faltpeters Win Hard Luck Game for Omaha, Dividing Series

RAGAN BY FAR OUTPITCHES M'KAY

Fa Forgets His Horsehoe and that Overnight Costs Him the Price of the Game.

Ragan was unfortunate to drop a game to Lincoln Thursday, the last game before the team starts west, but it was not his fault entirely the game was lost by the score of 4 to 2, after several ups and downs, with Omaha ahead on one stage.

Ragan pitched a magnificent game of ball, although his base on balls and hitting a man in the eighth inning had a great deal to do toward allowing Lincoln to score the last two runs which put it enough ahead to win the game.

Fa did not have his horsehoe with him again yesterday and everything went wrong. Gooding had a passed ball which let in the first run and Graham made an error in the first run which let in another, all of which helped to lose an otherwise close game.

Lincoln made the first run in the second inning when Davidson singled and was extinguished at second on Thomas' attempted sacrifice. Thomas went to third on Gagnier's hit, which, in itself, was a scratch as the ball hit Ragan on the shin and bounded out to right field when with the horsehoe pressed in to catch an out, Thomas scored on a passed ball, something very unusual for Johnny Gooding.

Omaha Ties the Score. Graham led off with a safe hit, his second of the game, and to second on Gooding's base on a passed ball and Graham scored on Ragan's error, his second of the game.

The eighth inning was disastrous for Omaha. Zinran hit a hard ball just inside the third strike and was sacrificed to second by McKay. Ragan hit Ketchum and Fenlon, hitting the bases with one out. Fenlon hit to Graham, who had plenty of time to catch Zinran at the home plate, but he threw wide and Gooding had to pull his glove off the plate to reach the ball. The mighty Davidson struck out and Thomas came to bat. Ragan had him struck out according to popular judgment (but here is where the majority does not rule), and that would have left the score a tie, but Umpire Brennan, who was at the sack, ruled otherwise. Thomas hit the next ball for a single to far for Autrey to reach and Ketchum and Fox scored. Fenlon was caught napping at second and the inning was over, but Lincoln was two runs to the good and that was enough to win the game.

Gagnier's hit was full of luck, for ordinarily it would have gone where some infielder would have captured it after bounding off Ragan's shin, but instead it hit the hole between Ragan and Fenlon.
