SOLUTION OF CITY PROBLEM

Co-operative Flat Building for People of Small Means.

NEW IDEA THAT MAY BE TRIED

Anchor Fence Company Gets Big Order from Burlington and Will Rush Its Delivery Without Delay.

With the steady advance in the price of land and homes in Omaha people are seeking some solution of the problem of owning a home close to the business part of the city.

But for those who want to live down town the solution which has been suggested is the co-operative apartment house or flat.

Such a house built by half a dozen artistically minded people of good taste can be made extremely attractive and far more homelike than the flat built by investors for mere rental purposes.

Successful experiments have just been completed by the Nebraska Concrete Reinforcing company in the coloring of concrete blocks.

The National Roofing company has taken the contract for roofing the Mount Loretta and the Thirty-second street schools which will be erected in Council Bluffs this summer.

Beautifulizing of the stations along the Burlington railroad line is receiving attention now, and an indication of this was an order received last week by the Anchor Fence company from N. Hopkins.

Worth's Chili Con Carne parlors are receiving a number of changes, among them will be the installation of six ventilating fans, which will thoroughly ventilate these parlors.

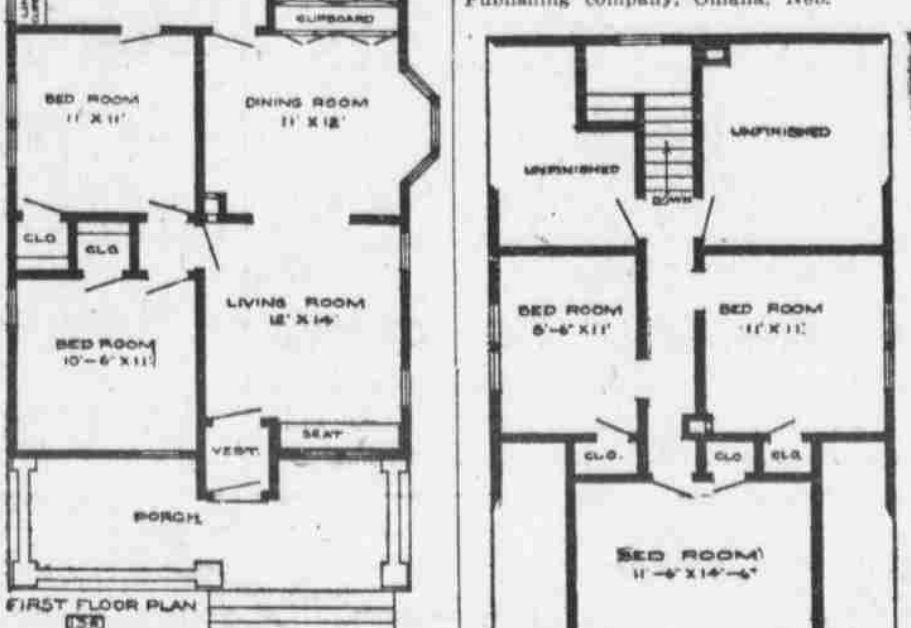
