FIRE LOSS AT PAWNEE, OKL. Entire Block Destroyed, with Damage of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars.

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okl., Dec. 8.—A message from Pawnee, Okl., states that a fire beginning about 2 o'clock this morning destroyed a whole block, causing a loss estimated at \$200,000. A high wind was blowing and all the fire department could do was to confine the fire to the one block. The fire started in the rear of O. P. C. Co., department store, destroying it, the Weinberg dry goods store, Robinson grocery store, the Globe hotel, Mentzer Brothers hardware store, the Masonic lodge building, the Yellowstone and Globe bars, the post office and postoffice newstand and a drug store. The cause of the fire is unknown. Insurance covers about one-fourth of the loss.
