PUMP TO BOOST IRRIGATION. Machine Touted as Means of Revolu-

D. Clem Deaver in charge of the Landseekers Information bureau of the passenger department of the Burlington is in unication with a large Wisconain concern manufacturing a new pump which the pompany maintains should be able to revolutionize the system of irrigation in many places in the west, especially in Wyoming where off and cost for fuel may be had it a alight cost.

"If this pump will do what the firm sinims it will do'it should be able immediately to throw open thousands of acres of valuable land to cultivation," said Mr. Deaver. "The pump has new features by which it is able to lift an enormous amount of water at a small expenditure of power. They claim they can lift twice as much water as four times the same amount of power would lift with any other pump.

be easy to find plenty of land on which to work their pumps. In western Nebraska there are immense stratches of land on which water might be pumped from neighporing streams with just such a pump. They say they can lift water from a depth of seventy-five feet and carry it as high as necessary. The water will not have to be lifted any such height.
