WINSTON CHURCHILL BEATEN

Member of New Liberal Cabinet is Defeated by Good Majority. BLOW TO THE GOVERNMENT. Sent Will Be Found Elsewhere for Defeated Man, but Result Will Affect Other Bye Elections.

MANCHESTER, Eng., April 25.—The northwest division of Manchester, by the heaviest poll cast in twenty years, today reversed its verdict of 1906 and by a majority of 45 votes, unseated as its member of Parliament Winston Spencer Churchill.

The defeat of Mr. Churchill is a crushing blow to the prestige of the government and the young and confident minister, which is bound to have a marked influence on several pending bye-elections.
