BRYAN MAY BOOST LOBECK
Scheme of Compensating for His Fight with John Johnson.
CLANS CALL TWO MEETINGS
City Comptroller Goes to Kansas City to Show Strength and Mayor Jim Skips Over to Chicago.

Will Bryan attempt to play to the Scandinavians in compensation for his fight with Governor Johnson of Minnesota by taking up the cudgel in behalf of Charles C. Lobeck, the Omaha candidate for governor of Nebraska, in opposition to National Committeeman Dahlman and two former candidates, George Washington Berge and Ashton C. Eshelberger?

When Bryan was in Omaha at the time of the Democratic convention last spring he had a long consultation with the comptroller and since then Lobeck has journeyed twice to Lincoln and once to Bryan's home at Fairview.

Read and Walsh Call It.
James Reed, former mayor of Kansas City and one of the delegates-at-large to the national convention, and Frank P. Walsh, prominent attorney of Kansas City and at one time a delegate to the supreme court of Missouri, have called the meeting of the clans, it is understood, and Lobeck will be asked to show what strength he can muster in the state, and also if his candidacy for governor of a state will in any way offset the disappointment among the people of his nationality in the event Johnson is defeated for the presidential nomination.

Mayor Dahlman also left the city quite unexpectedly Tuesday evening, his objective point being Chicago. The motive for his journey is not generally known, but city officials say they believe that Taggart and other leaders of the faithful are to have a meeting there for the purpose of discussing the political situation.

either by trestle or on higher ground, and they were practically out of danger. To stop these the water must rise several feet, and this appeared unlikely. All train service, however, was demoralized and but few trains in any direction were running on time.

Stock Yards Under Water.
At the stock yards business was nearly at a standstill. One quarter of the pens on the Missouri side were under water that stood from one to six feet deep. This flooded district covered fifty acres of the 200 acres set aside for pens.

Water Falling at Topeka.
TOPEKA, Kan., June 10.—The government weather gauge in the Kaw river at this point registered 28 feet at 5 o'clock, which is a fall of two feet since the water began to recede. This is at the rate of an inch an hour and will take the water back from the North Topeka houses and streets into the regular channel by late this afternoon.

Power on University President.
SAN FRANCISCO, June 10.—Power was conferred yesterday on President Benjamin Wheeler of the University of California, at a meeting of the board of university officers whereby if he should choose, he could resign his office at any time, and be reinstated for reasons of health or maintenance of every student at the institution and there would be no appeal.

BOYER RIVER OVERFLOWS.
LEAVENWORTH, Kan., June 10.—The Missouri river here is rising rapidly today. Already it has spread over the bottoms and in Platte county, across from Leavenworth, heavy damage has been done to farms. Much inconvenience was caused in Leavenworth today by the breaking of the leading gas main as a result of the flood.
