PA WINS ON WET GROUNDS

Three Scores in Seventh Inches Game Almost Lost.

SIoux LEAD FROM THE FIRST

Omaha, St. Louis, June 17.—One inning sufficed for Omaha to make enough runs to win from Sioux City Wednesday afternoon by the score of 3 to 1. It was another case where the gambler would have won on the proposition that the winning team would make more runs in the entire game.

Ducky Holmes and his rejuvenated Sioux came to Omaha on a rain cloud and confidently whispered it around that they intended to keep up the winning streak they had started on the Great Plains. They said they were no respecters of leaders or percentage tables, but intended to put Omaha back a few holes. Their intention was good, but their execution was poor.

Pa Fourks heard of these dire threats which had been made against the Merchants hotel, where the Sioux stopped, and after a consultation with Captain Franck decided to send the veteran War Sanders to the hilltop to stop the rush of the Sioux. Sanders took his point of vantage and headed off every rush they made.

Ducky started the first rush in the first round by making a hit. One run out and Wood hit the ball for Franck, who had a splendid chance to make a double play, but instead he muffed the grounder and both were safe. That gave Jack Henry much encouragement so he soaked a hard one through Sanders' hands and started on his way to the plate. Franck, who had been in the inning before a run was made.
