CROP REPORT IS GOOD ONE

Shows Conditions Along the Northwestern Railroad to be Encouraging.

Encouraging is the crop report for the current week which has been sent by the superintendents of the different divisions of the Northwestern to General Manager Walters. East of Long Pine to Fremont the weather has been ideal and the farmers are quite optimistic. The prospects are excellent for small grain and corn is rapidly coming to the front and with continued good weather will give a big yield.

The Bonesteel line makes the most encouraging report of any point on the Nebraska division. All the crops are doing well and promise a big yield. Indications on the South Platte are for from half a

wheat crop to a heavy crop; the oats are fine and the corn in good condition and growing fast.

On the Black Hills division the grain has shown the effects of the wet weather. The first crop of alfalfa is ready for cutting. The small grain is about ready to head out and corn promises good results. Between Chadron and Falls Fourche the season is not so far advanced.

Between Chadron and Long Pine the big crop is the potato crop, being the most important to the dwellers in that section. The potatoes are growing nicely. The acreage has increased and the prospects are better than they have been for some years.
