NOT AS STRONG AS EXPECTED

General Clearing Weather Over the Wheat and Corn Belt Eases Off the Local Market, with No Support.

Foreign cables do not answer the domestic advance of yesterday and were not as strong as expected. The general clearing weather over the wheat and corn belt has eased off the local market with no support.

Country advices are coming in more favorable and receipts are expected to increase July corn opened at 71c and closed at 70c. Primary wheat receipts are 310,000 bushels against 240,000 bushels against receipts of last year, 427,000 bu. and shipments of 210,000 bu.

Clearances were none of corn, 2,000 bu. of wheat and 1,000 bu. of flour, equal to 100,000 bushels of wheat.
