Coroner's Jury Simply Finds Mrs. Banner Killed Brother-in-Law. COUNTY ATTORNEY WILL ACT English Had Expected Inquest Would Lead to Recommendation that Woman Be Held for Trial.

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GIRL IS LEGALLY BEHEADED

Headman, According to Requirements, Dons Evening Clothes for Occasion in Saxony. PRESIDENT ON BETTER NAVY Wants First-Class Fighting Navy or None at All.

NEWMARKET, Saxony, July 22.—Grote Beier, the 18-year-old son of the mayor of Neumark, was beheaded last night some time between dark and dawn, in punishment for the murder of the man to whom she was engaged to be married. The executioner reached the city last night. He carried a box containing the ax with which he did his work, and brought with him also admitted wearing the official requirement of the sombre occasion. The preparations for the execution at the prison had been completed, and the man did his work quickly and privately and departed as quietly as he came. The king of Saxony had refused to grant a reprieve.
