American Protest Against Dorando is Allowed by Officials.

ITALIAN HELPED TO THE TAPE

Action of Officials Who Practically Carried Him to the Finish Gives Race to the Second Man.

LONDON, July 24.—The American protest against Dorando for receiving assistance at the finish of the Marathon race has been upheld. This makes John F. Hayes of the Irish-American Athletic club the winner of this world-famous event.

Italian in Bad Shape.
As soon as the Italian came into view it was seen that he was in very bad shape. He tottered brokenly toward the right when he should have turned to the left to make the circuit of two-thirds of the track necessary to reach the goal.
