INDUSTRIAL EXPO IN OMAHA

Enterprise to Display Manufactured Products is Proposed.

FACTORY MEN FAVOR THE IDEA

J. A. Sunderland of Commercial Club Committee Experts to Call Meeting for Discussion of This Plan.

To all the other exhibitions and attractions to be given in Omaha this fall and winter—and every year for many more seasons—may be added an industrial exposition which will give manufacturers of Omaha an opportunity to show the public what products they make and how some of them are made.

J. A. Sunderland, chairman of the manufacturers' committee of the Commercial club, expects to call a meeting of his committee within a short time. The subject of an industrial exposition to be held about January 1 will be the first one discussed. Mr. Sunderland proposes that his committee do something during the year. The Commercial club has twenty-five standing committees. Seven months have passed since they were appointed. Fewer than a dozen of them have accomplished anything and about a dozen have held one meeting. The transportation committee is always busy. The membership committee is now conducting a campaign to raise the membership to 1,000. The entertainment committee inaugurated the home trade excursion. The advertising committee has discussed city boosting. The trade extension committee organized the tri-state excursion and the municipal affairs committee "got busy" early in the year. What other committees have done the record tells not.

To the manufacturers the proposition of holding an industrial exposition appeals strongly. Last year the factories of Omaha produced \$20,000,000 worth of products. They ranged from refined metals to pearl buttons; from overalls to horse blankets,
