Let Time Limit Expire. "In the first place this action begun by James C. Ormsby, et al., will have absolutely no standing for the reason that they failed to appeal from the appraisal within the time limit," says Mr. Cornish.

Law on the Subject. "This is the law: If I make it known that I want a piece of land and you, without being hired by me, secure an option on that land in my name, saying that you are acting for me even though unknown to me, and I afterward approve your act and take over the property, you are and have been in fact my lawful agent and I am bound for your acts. This is the law."

Right to Accept Donations. "The charter and the statutes of the state both give us the right to accept donations, and as far as appraising the total lands at least the \$50,000 the appraiser decided that it was not worth more than \$50,000, under the law, we would have had to reject the appraisal and appoint a board composed of seven instead of three members, for the law provides that property valued in excess of \$50,000 must be appraised by the larger board."
