

TERMINAL TAX LOWERS LEVY

Adding Million to Assessment Roll Cuts Combined Rate.

FOUR MILLS UNDER LAST YEAR

Use Refuses to Sign, Saying: "Let the Fellow Who Refused to Add the Million Be Responsible."

The combined tax levy of the city, school district, county and state probably will be in the neighborhood of 4 mills less than they were last year, when the county board completes its work Thursday afternoon.

After deciding on the county levy in committee of the whole Wednesday, the board failed to act Thursday morning because of the refusal of the city to sign the report.

Let the fellows who refused to add \$1,000,000 to the levy estimate assessment last year make the levy and be responsible for it," he said when the report was handed to him.

This year the total levies will amount to about 1.54 per cent of the full value of property while last year it was 1.99 per cent.
