

GRAIN AND PRODUCE MARKET

Values Show Continuation of Previous Day's Strength

PRICES ARE STEADILY ADVANCING

More Bullish Sentiment General Throughout the Trade on Dry Seeding Reports and Lighter Country Receipts.

OMAHA, Oct. 8, 1908. Today's grain values show a continuation of yesterday's closing strength and prices are steadily advancing.

Wheat was firm from the start on bullish reports, and buying was active. Cables were higher and the advance made rapid headway.

Corn opened strong with wheat and buying was persistent. Offerings came slow and bidding was necessary to bring out the stuff.

Primary wheat receipts were 1,800,000 bu. and shipments were 720,000 bu. against 1,800,000 bu. and shipments of 600,000 bu. last week.

CHICAGO GRAIN AND PROVISIONS Features of the Trading and Closing Prices on Board of Trade.

CHICAGO, Oct. 8.—A net advance of 1/4c to 1 1/2c was made in the price of wheat on the local exchange today as a result of an active general demand based chiefly on record-breaking receipts at Minneapolis.

Nearly every commission house represented on the floor of the exchange had buying orders for wheat.
