

POULTRY SHOW IS GROWING

Plans Laid for Bigger Exhibition Than Ever Next Year.

DOG FANCIERS ALSO ENTHUSE

Kennel Club Will Hold Large Exhibit Under Auspices of National Association—New Year's Crowd Throng Aisles.

From early morn to late at night on New Year's day the aisles at the fourth annual poultry show of the Trans-Mississippi association were crowded with an eager throng of spectators, all anxious to see the chickens and ducks and geese and peacocks which have been attracting so much attention during the week.

Competition has been keen in most of the classes and the professional breeders of poultry have found they had as many as fifty in carrying off the ribbons. The number of poultry fanciers is increasing each year and each year there are just that many more exhibitors at the show.
