Contributors Lead in Their Branches and Papers Valuable as Covering Latest Thought and Discovery in the Several Fields.

The annual report of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution for 1907, transmitting to congress, as required by law, a statement of the operations, expenditures and condition of the institution and its branches for the year, has just been issued.

In this report, the policy adopted very soon after the founding of the institution in 1846, of adding to the official proceedings and transactions of its governing bodies, a selection of papers on many scientific subjects, has been continued. These additional papers, twenty-nine in number, gathered from many sources, are designed to portray in general the scientific progress of the world during the year. Some of them are prepared especially for the purpose of being reprinted from scientific and technical journals that have not a popular circulation, many being translated from foreign tongues.
