NEW YORK, Feb. 6.—The undertone in the general list of stocks continued depressed today and the effect was especially noticeable in the case of underdone stocks.

Reaction from the advances of the earlier part of the week was noticeable in some of the latter class of stocks. The rather firm tone of the money market and expectation of a bank statement showing a clear decrease in the margin of the surplus were advanced as ostensible reasons for some of the selling of stocks.

The bearish traders protested some appreciation over the Japanese question and the desire to await the final action of the California legislature on the bill to regulate Japanese pupils in the public schools was cited as an influence in the days' market.
