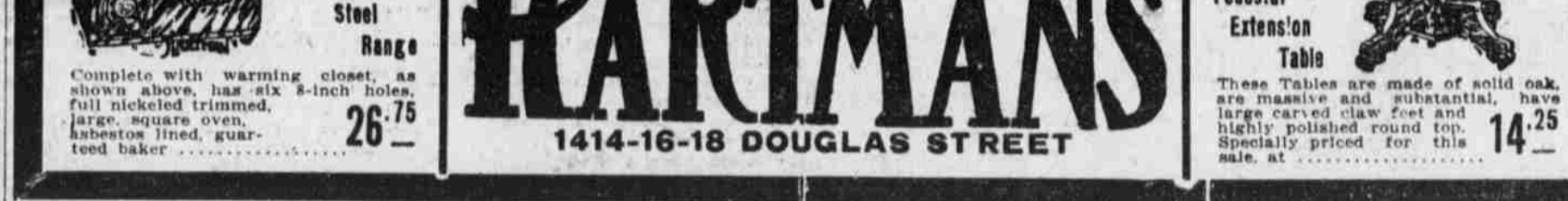

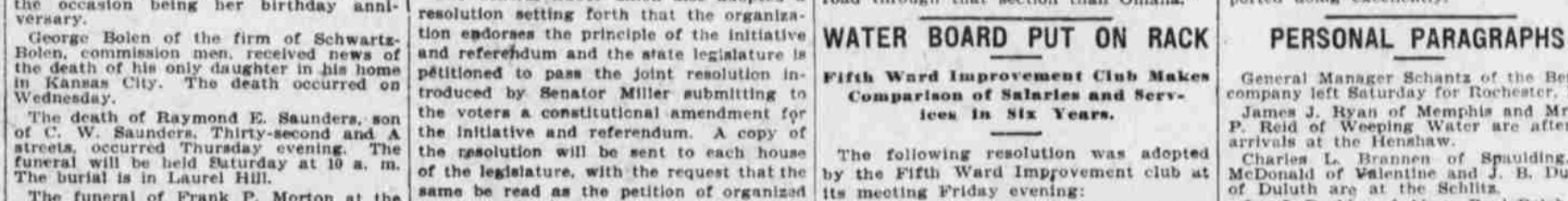

Innovations at Packing Plants. The Omaha Packing company has installed one of the new scrapers for the rapid dressing of hogs, such as is in use in Armour & Co.'s plant. This scraper is a horizontal machine instead of the old vertical cylinder commonly in use. The hair is taken off by a revolving apparatus constructed of flexible belting with a metal scraper fixed at the end. The hogs are carried between two of these beaters. The work is much more rapid and effective than the old method and has proved a great success at Armour & Co. The other packers are now installing the scrapers as fast as the condition of their machinery will make advisable.

At Kansas City, Armour & Co. are experimenting with a moving platform for the cattle beds, and it is said the new device is likely to meet with success in Chicago also. One of the principal advantages is that it requires each butcher to work up to a certain standard of rapidity to keep the carcasses moving. The other plants have not yet been convinced that there is any great advantage in moving beds. It may be installed in Armour & Co.'s South Omaha plant.
