Cash values on the floor are steady, with prices for the present crop. May wheat advanced to 1.07 1/2 and closed at 1.07 1/2. Corn ruled 57 1/2 and closed at 57 1/2. Values were firm in face of heavy offerings on the market being well supported under the influence of a steady price for strong on prevailing prices and with heavy receipts were quiet active.
