Foreign Markets Continue Strong and Prices Higher.

BULLIED BY FEAR OF SHORTAGE

Strength in European Markets, Coupled with Excellent Domestic Demand, Keeps Prices Up Well.

Foreign markets continue strong and higher, influenced by the fear of a shortage in future supplies.

Corn acted dull and took little strength with wheat. Receipts are unusually good and the demand is dropping off slightly.

Wheat opened steady on strong foreign news, but weakened slightly toward the close.

Country receipts have been liberal, but are extended for 30 days delivery.

Primary wheat receipts were 600,000 bushels and shipments were 240,000 bushels.

NEW YORK STOCKS AND BONDS

Market Opens Active and Higher, but Reaction Soon Ensues.

SHARP BREAK IN READING

Belief in General that Commodities Rate Case Will Go Against the Railroads - Day's Net Changes Small.

NEW YORK, Feb. 27.—The professional contingent was active during the first part of the Stock exchange which ended with a sharp break in reading.

The strong upward impetus during the first part of the day was due to the belief in general that commodities rate case will go against the railroads.

The way thus opened for reaction and additional force was exerted by the sympathetic influence of the break in reading.

This was based on the dread of the decline of the market, and the fear of a settlement between Austria and Serbia.

The strength of the market was a reflection of the confidence in the government.

Some features of domestic politics also figured in the strength of the market.

Operators who participated in the market were satisfied with its tenor and a belief that business confidence would be fostered by its contents.

There were in circulation in the financial district well-kept records of the progress of the shipping for moderation in the revision of the tariff and that the force of events in the trade would be expected to exert their influence in that direction.

The market gave no evidence of an important change in participation on the part of the small net changes at the end of the day in spite of the considerable volume of transactions.

Some of the professional traders on the floor of the exchange were slightly more active in the afternoon, but most of it was traceable to the return of banks.

The panics outside the clearing house, which were neutralized by the low contraction incident to the stock market liquidation of the day.
