Water Supply a Touchy Subject

Real Estate Exchange Argues in Extensive Without Definite Result.

Bills proposing to give the Omaha Water board more power, confiscating what power the board now possesses and reiterating the right of the people to vote franchises were discussed by the Omaha Real Estate exchange, Wednesday.

As soon as the secretary's minutes were approved, the water works question was brought up in its relation to the Boland bill. J. H. Dumont reminded the members that it was thus to do something, as the company was running pumps at a pressure which threatened to burst the main from Chicago to Omaha, and cut off the entire water supply of the city; that judging from the quality of water furnished it was a question with citizens whether they

should eat the water and drink mashed potatoes. He said the reserve supply in the Walnut Hill reservoir was sufficient to last Omaha only about twelve hours.

Other members opposed the measure Mr. Dumont favored because "people were being robbed of their rights." D. C. Patterson claimed the Water board already had the right to compromise with the Water company and buy the plant for a lesser amount than the appraised valuation, but others took the view that conferring a judgment was about the only choice of the city and such an action did not harmonize well with compromising.
