

DENVER REJECTS LOW RATES

Protests Against Freight Tariffs Lower Than Others Get.

ACTION CREATES MUCH SURPRISE

Reason Assigned is that Schedules Were Readjusted on Principle Involved in Missouri River Case, Which is Bad.

If a man can put back things he takes; if an Indian can still give away things and call for them later; if a shoe still pinches at home, Omaha will be allowed to keep a considerable area of trade territory without fear of successful competition from either Chicago or Denver.

This unexpected news was broken to the Commercial club transportation committee Wednesday when it was learned that Denver had protested against being given lower rates by order of the Interstate Commerce commission.

Resolutions have been passed by the Colorado Manufacturers' association, the Denver Chamber of Commerce and the Denver Board of Trade, asking that the Interstate Commerce commission not put the new rate into effect May 1, as ordered.

The reason given for this action is that the rates were readjusted on the principle involved in the Burnham-Hanna-Munger dry goods case, known as the Missouri river case, which is still in the courts.

Principle is Wrong.

Though Denver was given reductions of from 14 to 25 cents per 100 pounds on freight from Chicago, the commercial organizations turn directly around and say the principle laid down in the Missouri river case is destructive to the now recognized jobbing centers. They want this decided by the courts before it is recognized as a basis for readjustment of rates.

Such action is quite satisfactory here. It was in anticipation that Denver would forget making the fight for the reductions and take some action to keep the rates from going into effect, that the Commercial club of Omaha kept its hands off and filed no protest against the new schedule, which would have gone into effect May 1 and eliminated a big slice of territory from Omaha.

The old rates were as follows from Chicago to Denver:

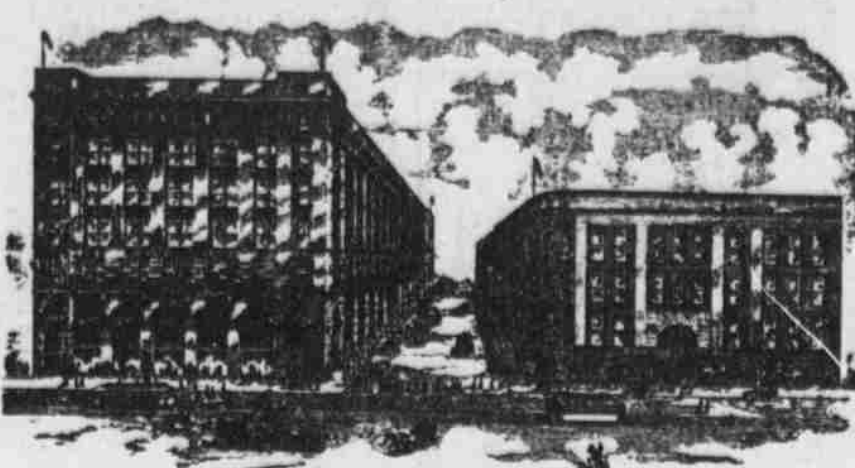
