Wheat Again Nervous After Steady and Higher Opening.

RAIDED BY SHORT SELLING

Foreign News Shows Signs of Strengthening—Means the Supply of Wheat Will Be Very Short.

OMAHA, April 23, 1910. Generally fair weather prevailed this morning in the lake region, the upper Mississippi valley, the Missouri valley and throughout the northern Rocky mountain plateau and north Pacific coast.

Wheat was very nervous again. A steady and higher opening in the market was raided again by short selling and unloading of long wheat by weak holders.

Corn was under heavy liquidation and a severe decline in the market was observed. The weakness in wheat and free selling was the feature for a decline.
