

lowa WORKMEN DEMAND THEIR PAY Incipient Riot in City Hall in Des Moines. MAYOR EXPLAINS SITUATION He Says Pay Roll Must Be Passed by Council and Promises to Call a Special Session.

(From a Staff Correspondent.) DES MOINES, June 12.—(Special Telegram.)—Demanding their pay and threatening violence if they did not get it immediately, more than fifty of the 150 men discharged by Councilman MacVicar last night gathered on the steps of the city hall this morning to await the arrival of Mayor Mathis.

The discharged employes began congregating in little groups soon after 7 o'clock. In irate tones they swore vengeance against the city officials, demanding reinstatement, and as soon as the mayor's door was thrown open the entire assemblage crowded in and formed a semicircle around his chair.

"What will it be, gentlemen?" asked the mayor of his angry callers. One of the number acted as spokesman and demanded that because they had been discharged their wages be paid to them at once.

The mayor explained that the pay roll would have to go through the regular channels of the council, but promised to call a special meeting this afternoon for their allowance, provided they would be ready by that time. The regular payday is not until a week from Monday, and the emergency fund provided for the payment of discharged employes is limited to \$100.

Iowa Money Market. The report of the state banking department today shows that at the close of business on May 18, 1909, there were in the 529 savings banks, 263 state banks and fifteen trust companies deposits amounting to \$225,156,161, an increase over the report of February 20, 1909, of \$1,966,635.27.
