**Stock Yards to Make City Horse Center**

Demands of Eastern Buyers Cause Extension of Facilities for Trading at South Omaha.

Demands of eastern buyers who want to get horses in the Omaha market and shippers who believe Omaha is the best point in the country to which horses can be shipped and sold at the best prices, have caused the Union Stock Yards company to plan the erection of one large horse barn this year, to be followed by two others as soon as arrangements can be made for location and contracts closed with some horsemen who desire to use the barns.

The number of horses being shipped to Omaha is increasing. Monday of this week is typical of how horses are coming in. Though it was comparatively a quiet day in cattle and hogs, some thirty-five carloads of horses arrived in South Omaha.

Besides the western and native horses which come the market has developed a strong demand for blooded animals.

Each year and sometimes more often buyers of horses for the express companies and big transfer lines are on the market at big sales to secure high-grade horses for cities in all parts of the United States. Many of these horses are now bought in Omaha and thousands more will be brought here and sold when the stock yards company completes its plans for accommodating a larger market.

Some of the leading horsemen of the country are anxious to ship to Omaha and the buyers who come from Maine to Florida and from New York City to Chicago have signified their desire to meet the horsemen in Omaha.
