CUDAHY BUYING ON DOUGLAS

Secures More Property on That Street and Seeks Grossman Home.

NO PLANS FOR BUILDINGS NOW

Packer Says He Would Sell the Property—Will Sure Give Ak-Sar-Ben Its Right-of-Way This Fall.

E. A. Cudahy, vice president and general manager of the Cudahy Packing company, is negotiating for more Douglas street property, including the corner at Seventeenth and Douglas streets known as the Grossman home.

Samson Is Welcome

"Ak-Sar-Ben will use it again?" "Yes, Samson can rent most anything I have."

The corner of Seventeenth and Douglas streets is said to be worth between \$5,000 and \$6,000. Some place between these amounts a price has been named by an agent of the owners and Mr. Cudahy says he will take the property at the figure mentioned.

Other property in the same block is offered for sale by Omaha agents and it is understood the entire block with the exception of the Cole-McKay undertaking establishment is likely to change hands during the summer, owners feeling that the present is, perhaps, the best time to dispose of their holdings.

Soon Commission Firms Must Give Bonds in Business

After First of Month They Shall Put Up Security to Deal Fairly with Patrons.

Commission men and bond company agents are playing hide and seek these days, for July 1 the law goes into effect whereby dealers in produce must bind themselves to the county judge in the sum of \$2,000 to deal fairly and equitably with their clients.

Simonton & Browne is the first Omaha firm to qualify as the law directs, having filed their bond with the county clerk Friday morning. The bond states that the firm has made application for a license—this costs \$10—and covenants that it shall well and truly perform all agreements with respect to consignors as regards the receiving and handling, selling and making remittances and payments in accordance with the law of the state of Nebraska.

There are at least fifty houses in Omaha that must file a bond of the kind.

Consignors of produce, it is expected, will welcome the enforcement of the law.

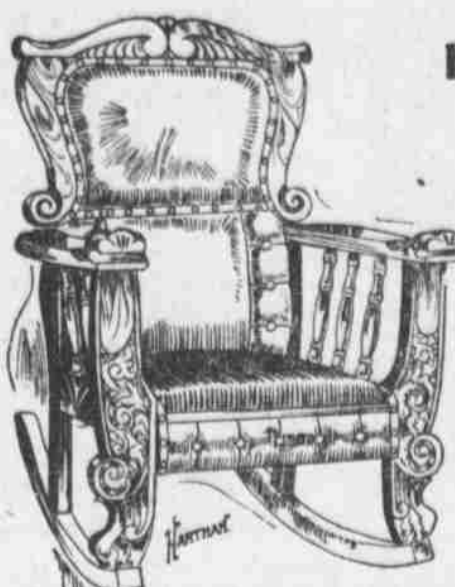
