## COME TO SEE OMAHA GROW

The Minnesota real estate men are making a trip through the west, mainly for pleasure, but at the same time they are stopping at many of the larger western cities to consult with other real estate dealers. Other cities that will be visited by them are Denver, Colorado Springs, Portland, Tacoma and Seattle. The return trip will be made to Minneapolis by the way of the Great Northern.

Want to See Omaha.

Mr. Cone, president of the board, said the trip out to the coast would have been made over the Great Northern, but the party wanted to have a day in Omaha, so they decided to come by this city on the way out.

"Omaha was made one of the objective points of the trip," said Mr. Cone, "for the real estate men of the Twin Cities are interested in watching this city's growth. Omaha is regarded as a big place up in our country."

"This is the first time I have been in Omaha and I am anxious to see what you have here. You have the location here for a future Greater Omaha, and I believe you are destined to become that."
