Army Notes

Simmonds; First Lieutenants George H. White, R. W. Drury, R. J. West; Second Lieutenants N. W. Riley, C. K. Nulsen, H. C. Fooks, with First Lieutenant D. E. Shean as judge advocate. All the officers are of the Sixteenth Infantry.

TRYING OUT THE MOTOR CARS

Rock Island Will Make Test of Several for Its Branch Line Service.

The Rock Island and the Santa Fe have decided to use motor cars on their branch lines to cut down operating expenses through districts where the travel is not very heavy. The Rock Island has decided to give the various makes of cars a test before buying and to that end five different types of cars will be put in service in competition with the McKen motor car. The General Electric company has built a new car, from which it expects great things and it will enter the contest. It is a gasoline electric car of 250 horse power. It will be put in service between Chanute and Pittsburg, Kan. A steam motor car of the new type has also been entered in the competition. One of the McKen motors is now in daily service on the Northern Pacific and is used to haul a large passenger coach on its trip over a branch line.
