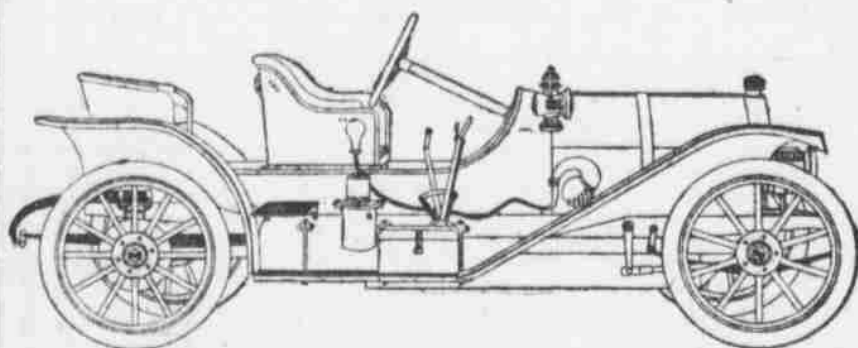

FROM WASHINGTON TO BOSTON

Reliability Contest Over Eastern Roads in September.
NEW YORK, Aug. 7.—The pathfinding Chalmers-Detroit car will lay out the route for the Frank A. Munsey "reliability run" from Washington to Boston and return, September 21 to 29. This will be the longest touring event in the east this year, and although it was announced only a few weeks ago, eight factories have entered cars and twenty-two entries are practically assured, with many others hanging fire. As the Glidden tour was early and entirely in the west this year, the Munsey run will offer the sole opportunity for manufacturers to try out their 1910 models

on an extensive scale in 1909, but private owners are evincing as much interest as the factories and dealers. Although the work of organizing the tour has scarcely advanced beyond the preliminary stage, individual entrants are among the most prominent features of the early developments. Three handsome trophies have been offered for the three classes—touring cars, miniature tonneau and double rumble cars and touring runabouts.

The scout car is the Chalmers-Detroit "30," the flag-to-flag car, which made the famous gruelling scouting trip from Denver to Mexico City. Its tentative course will be from Washington to Baltimore, via Laurel; Baltimore to Philadelphia, via York and Lancaster, Pa.; Philadelphia to Mil-

ford, Pa., via the Delaware Water Gap; Milford to Albany, Albany to Boston, via Springfield; one or two days' stay in Boston, then Boston to New York by the straightest course; New York to Philadelphia, possibly via Atlantic City; Philadelphia to Washington, via Baltimore. The total distance will be about 1,500 miles.

Dates for Golf.

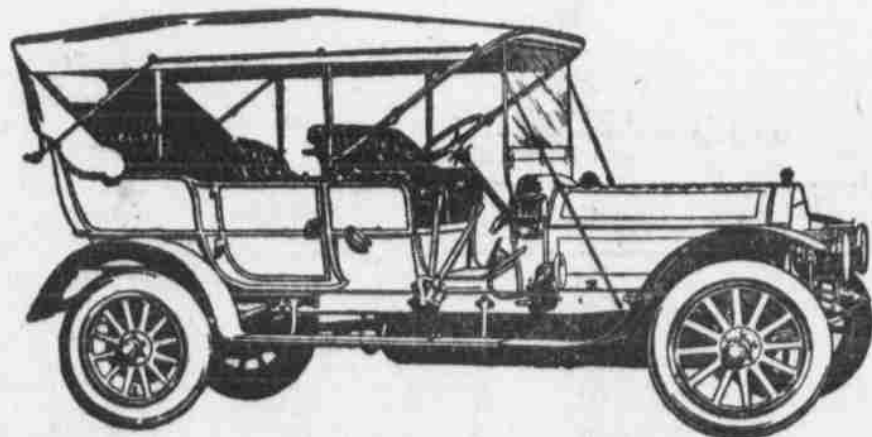

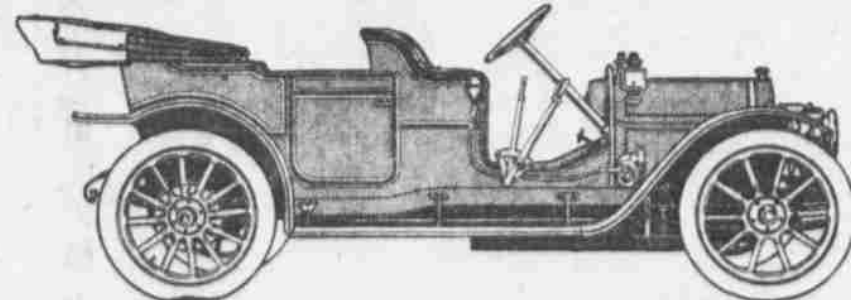

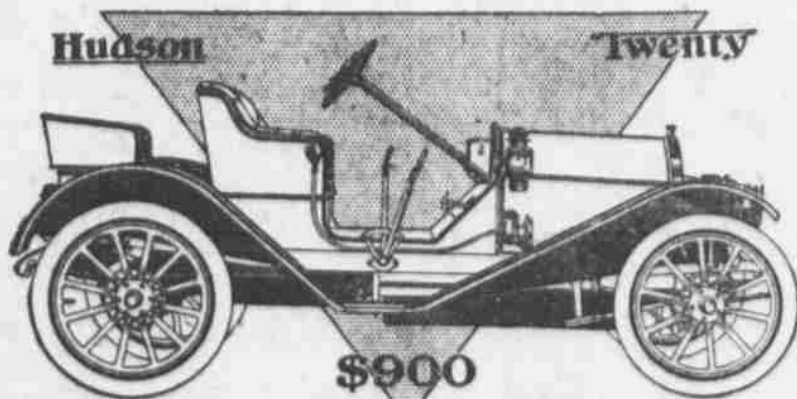
