OMAHA, Aug. 23, 1909. Lower cables started heavy selling again today. The spring wheat movement has been and receipts were noticeably increased by the northwestern markets. Light scattered showers fell in the corn belt and, moreover, the general market was closed unimpaired and prices slumped. Wheat slumped again after a weak start on favorable trading and returns, and a general bearish sentiment due to the expected large movement. Cash wheat prices were generally lower, with a few exceptions. Corn opened weak on reported rains and values kept slipping lower during the whole session. More rain is reported and further declines are probable as the larger commission houses are selling on all bulks.
