STEEL CARS AND BIG ENGINES

New Equipment is Bought by the Northwestern Line. COACHES WILL BE FIREPROOF

This Road Also Increases the Carrying Capacity of Its Freight Cars Fifteen Per Cent Per Mile.

Seventy-five new Pacific type passenger engines have been ordered by the Northwestern for delivery during the next two or three months for use on all its through passenger trains.

The Northwestern has also increased the carrying capacity about 15 per cent per mile of its freight cars by the purchase during the last twelve months of 8,000 freight cars of modern type and capacity.

These will assist most materially in the heavy grain movements which are soon to start. The average of most roads is seven cars to the mile, but the Northwestern now has an average of eight freight cars to the mile.

The Northwestern has decided to replace its present passenger equipment as fast as possible with steel cars and coaches. These will be placed for 125 steel fireproof coaches, chair cars, parlor cars, dining cars, postal cars and baggage cars for early delivery.

These will all be equipped with noncollapsible heavily reinforced steel frames with the most modern vestibule, high speed equipment and the latest improved draft gear.

The floors will be laid with a sanitary composition that adds strength to the car and deadens the noise of the trains. The seat frames are steel and no combustible material has been used in the construction. The new equipment will be provided for all the through passenger trains.

Physicians Look with Approval Upon Decision to Delay Wedding While Ill.

Edward Cudahy's refusal to endanger the health of his prospective bride is assuming the proportions of a national discussion with physicians all over the land declaring that the young man has done well.

Interviews with eminent authorities on tuberculosis as regards the decision of Mr. Cudahy were printed in Chicago papers yesterday. Dr. Henry St. Paul of the Chicago Tuberculosis Institute, declaring:

"It was a wise precaution to take, and it would be well for all persons who have pathognomonic symptoms to be careful before entering upon the marital state. While it is no longer generally believed that diseases such as tubercular infections are inherited by the children of afflicted parents, the danger lies in another direction.

"Such infections are contagious and can be transmitted by the husband to the wife, or by a near in the household, and it would be difficult to maintain the conditions of hygiene in the family that such contagion would not be possible.

"In all such cases I would consider it wise to pursue the same course as Mr. Cudahy and postpone the wedding until the disease has been eradicated and until their physicians have advised them that there is no further danger of spreading the contagion."

Dr. W. T. Beifeld, secretary of the Chicago Society for Social Hygiene, said: "Of course I have nothing about this individual case and cannot say whether there would be any actual danger either to his prospective bride or their possible progeny if young Mr. Cudahy were to marry at this time, but the thing that strikes me favorably and forcibly is that he has taken precaution."

"That is a thing that we have been trying to teach. We have preached and written against hasty marriages among diseased persons, for while neither I nor others who have studied the question of heredity believe that there is such a thing as an inherited disease, I do feel certain that it is frequently impossible to prevent the transmission of a disease from the parent to a child."
