Woman Kills Self With Gas

Mary Altman of Los Angeles is Found Wrapped in Blanket Dead in Her Room.

Miss Mary Altman, who has been living in apartments at 1544 North Sixteenth street, was found dead in her room by residents of the apartment, about 9 a. m. Monday.

Death evidently had resulted from the inhalation of illuminating gas, self-administered. The body was found wrapped in a blanket, which enveloped it completely, into which had been thrust the end of a rubber tube connected with a gas jet, from which gas was still flowing.

Officer Morgan, who investigated the case, was able to learn little about the girl save that she is said to have relatives in Los Angeles.

No reason for her suicide is known. Miss Altman was 41 years of age.

ONE MAN SHOT AND OTHER SLASHED WITH A KNIFE

Two Are Found in Room and Arrested While Police Investigate Mystery.

Phillip Viann and Tony Lobue, who say they are laborers, were found under suspicious circumstances in their room at 122 North Tenth street by Officers Shepherd and Walker. Viann was suffering from a bullet wound in his right forearm and Lobue bore a fresh knife cut on his forehead.

When taken to the police station the men professed to be unable to speak the English language and an interpreter was called. Through him they said they had just emerged from their door after dinner, when a man stepped up, shot one through the arm and knifed the other.

The story sounded so fishy to the police that the men were locked up pending an investigation.

A trail of blood led from the door of the small frame shack occupied by them, in company with several other Italians, nearly to the river. A pool of blood was also found near a cot in their room.

Alfred Henry Lewis, the war correspondent and news writer, was one of the advance guards to President Taft, and left Omaha to intercept the president at Denver.
