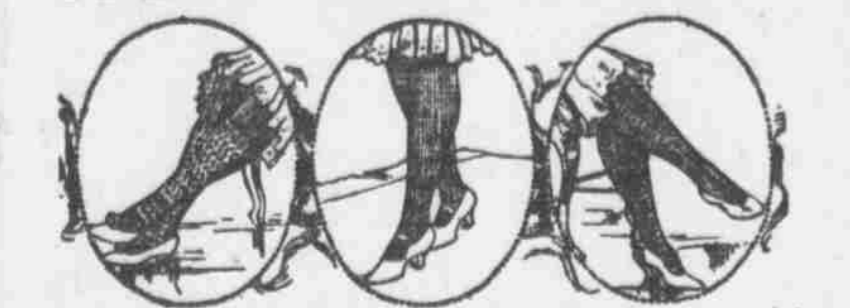

Macadam Road to Be Built to the Sarpy Line

Proposition Will Come Before City Council and Boards of the Two Counties.

The building of a macadamized street from Thirtieth and Vinton streets through Clontarf and South Omaha and on into Sarpy county, is the object of a meeting of the city council, the county commissioners, the South Omaha council and the Sarpy county commissioners, to be held at the city hall a week from Saturday. A preliminary session, in which members of the Omaha and South Omaha councils and some of the county commissioners participated, has been held in

South Omaha, but no definite action was taken.

It was decided, however, to make an effort to have the Park board do the work in Omaha, as the property abutting the street is of such a nature it is feared it would not stand the necessary tax to complete it. The county is expected to do the constructing work through Clontarf precinct and the South Omaha council through South Omaha. The Sarpy county commissioners may after this work is done decide to continue the pavement into Sarpy county.
