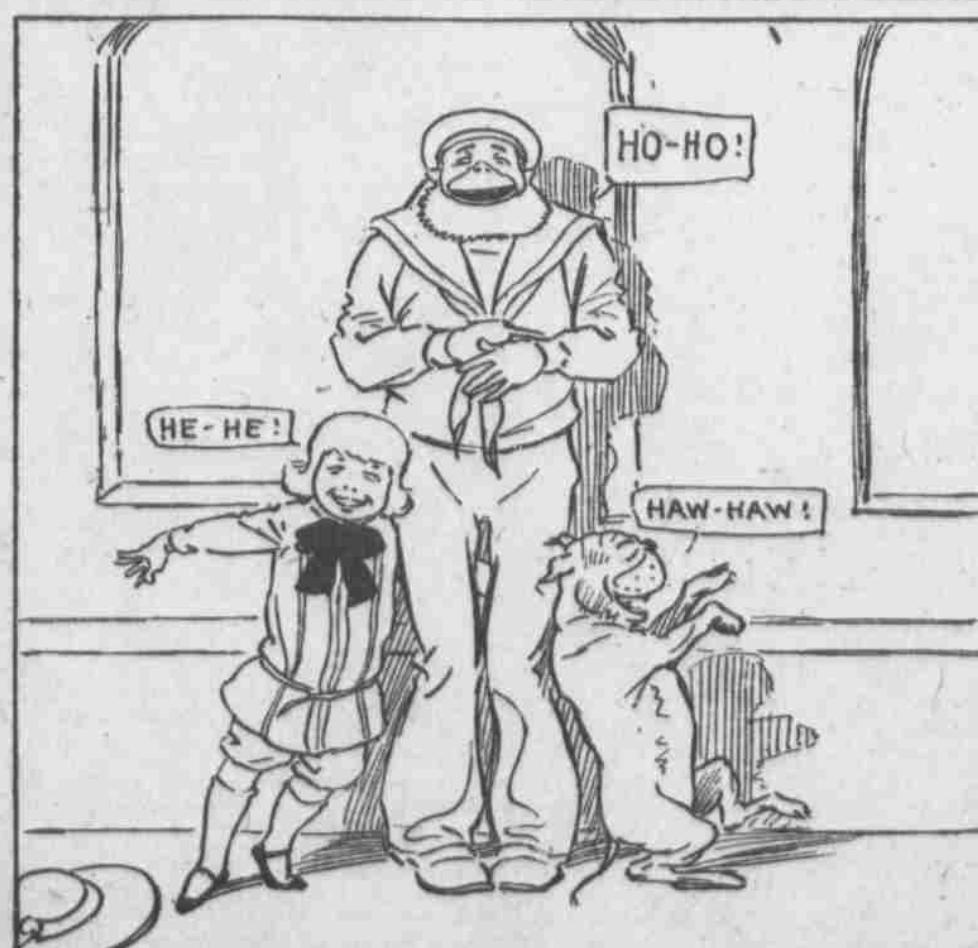
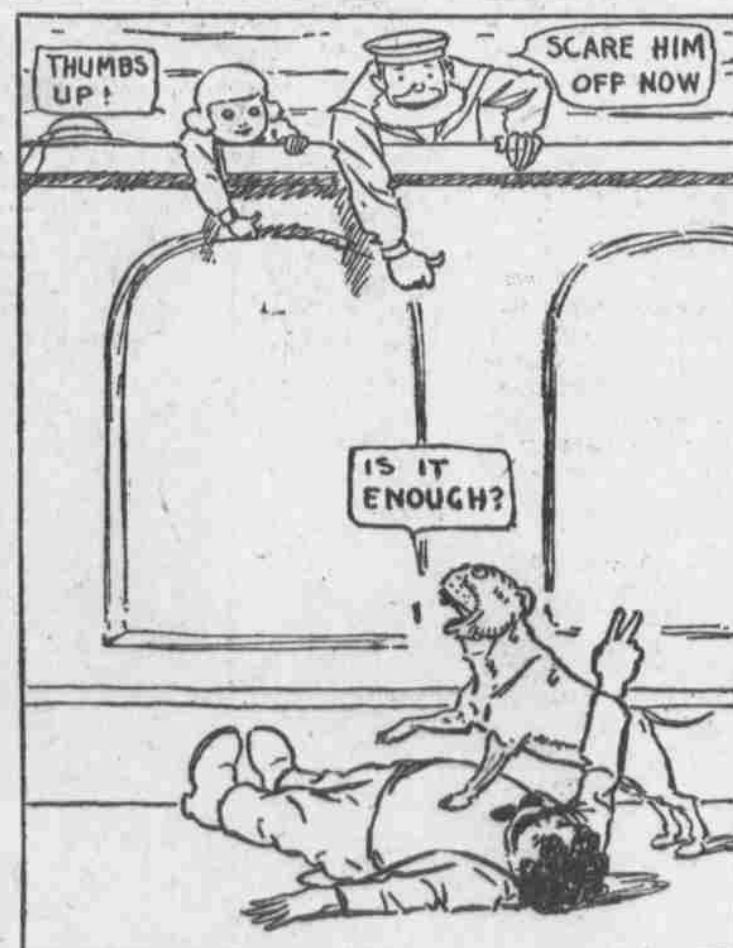
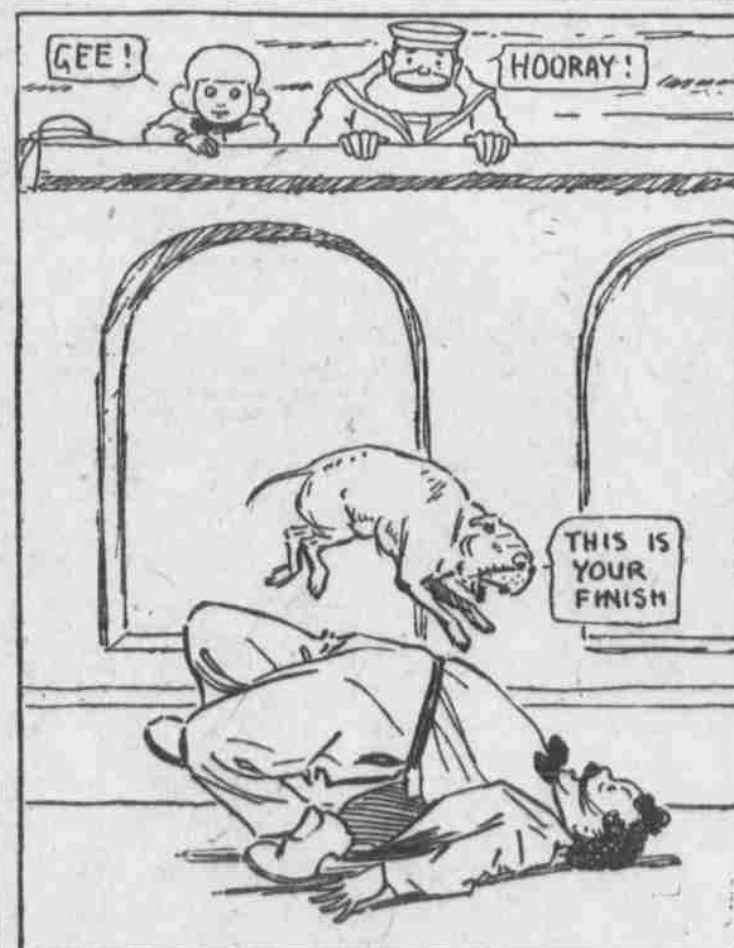
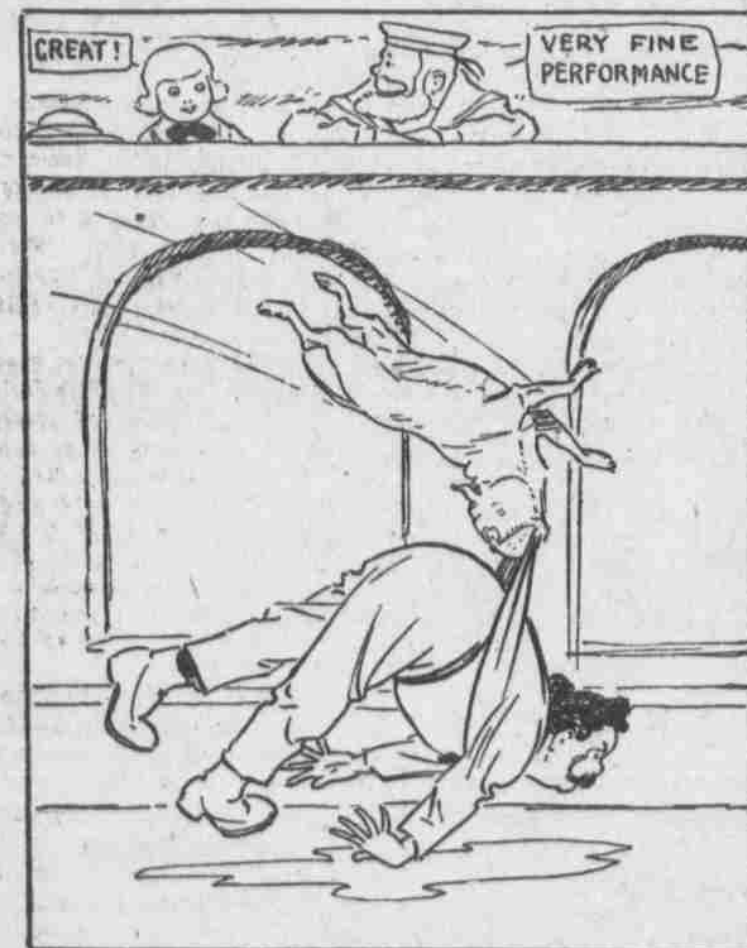
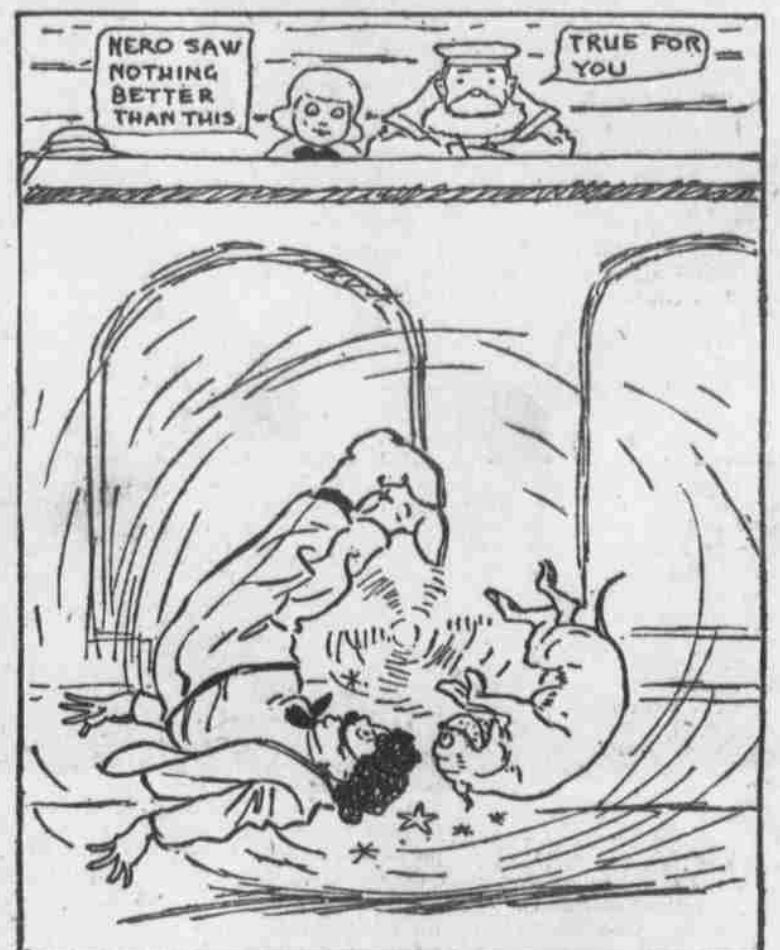
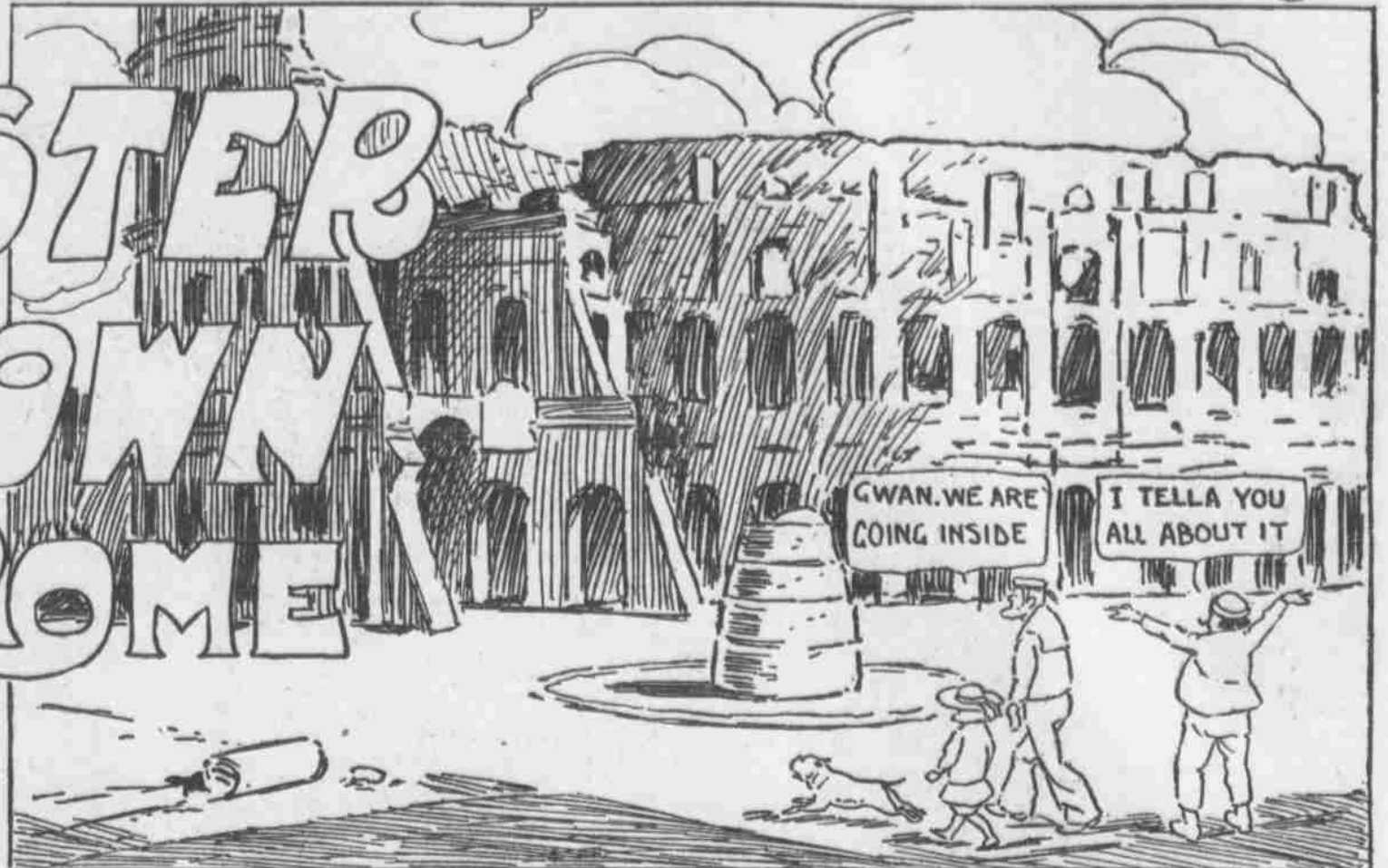


BUSTER BROWN IN ROME
