The Department of Agriculture estimates that the corn crop of the United States this year will amount to 2,757,214,000 bushels. At the current prices this represents a value of more than \$1,900,000,000—almost \$2,000,000,000.

The third annual National Corn show will be held in Omaha early in December, and at this exhibition King Corn will hold court. The first annual show was held in Chicago three years ago.

The versatility of corn surpasses that of any other grain. At a recent exposition no less than 100 separate and distinct commercial products from corn were exhibited.

More corn to the acre! is the slogan of the National Corn show. James G. Blaine once predicted that corn would become the backbone of agriculture in the United States, and the prophecy long since has been fulfilled.

It is a distressing fact that the figures for 1908 show an average yield of corn amounting to only 25.2 bushels to the acre. This is but little larger than the average yield of all the years since the close of the Civil War.
