### BRUNING'S VOTE ELECTS HIM

Swallowed as Bitter Pill by Bedford and Pickard for Chairman.

TRAINOR VOTES FOR J. A. SCOTT

Bruning Has Boldness to Announce There Was Nothing "Fixed" About His Electing, Adding, "In a Way."

Fred Bruning's own vote re-elected himself chairman of the Board of County Commissioners for the year 1910, at the organization meeting held Tuesday

Bruning had three votes and John A. Scott one. Jeff W. Bedford, O. J. Pickard and Bruning voted for Bruning. P. J. Trainor cast the ballot for Mr. Scott, who was abseit on account of illness.

Bruning, elected to the county board as republican, has again committed the deed of party treachery which elected him to the chairmanship in January, 1908, and will pay the same price as before-casting his vote for the men whom Commissioners Bedford and Pickard select for county appointments.

The result was without surprise. After County Clerk Haverly had called the meeting to order, Commissioner Pickard moved that the board proceed to elect a chairman by ballot. The votes were cast and Mr. Pickard stepped forward as one teller. County Clefk Haverly summoned Commissioner Trainor to act as another counter.

"It's superfluous," said Trainor, as he stepped forward. "This is pretty well cut and dried."

Neither Commissioner Pickard nor Bedford looked particularly happy over the result of the election. They have admitted that Bruning is a bitter pill to swallow, Funny, but Don't Know It.

Bruning himself injected considerable humor of the unconscious variety into the meeting by an address. Also he declared, "The election is rather a surprise to me, for there was nothing really fixed up, in a

This remark was made to reporters. In his more formal address Bruning delivered himself of several gems of thought.

"The reason I wanted to be re-elected," said he, "was that I think every chairman of every committee has worked faithfully and efficiently, and so I didn't see any reason for any change. I want to thank the superintendents of institutions who have co-operated with us and I want to ask their co-operation to co-operate with one alm this year.
