EASY FOR SAUNDERS COUNTY

Old Bill Commuted by Valley Bridge Agreement Between Boards.

ONLY WAY, DECLARES BOARD

Commissioners Contend that Otherwise Claim Could Not Likely Be Collected—Some Expenditure Figures.

The contract made by Douglas county with Saunders respecting a new bridge over the Platte at Valley is arousing a variety of opinions and there is considerable sentiment that Douglas county is getting the worst of the deal.

The county commissioners of Saunders county have agreed to pay one-fourth the cost of the steel spans, the bill for which will be \$12,000 to \$15,000, and one-fourth the cost of abutments. On the other hand, Douglas county agrees to drop a little back bill against Saunders county for \$2,000.

In other words, the commissioners of Saunders get a bill of \$6,000 cancelled in return for an expenditure of about one-half that sum.

Arguing in behalf of their bargain, members of the Douglas county board assert that it is doubtful if they could force Saunders county to pay anything at all toward the new bridge, and to this it is answered that no attempt worthy the name has ever been made to collect the old \$2,000 either by legal procedure or even moral persuasion.

Bridges have been costing Douglas county taxpayers all kinds of money in the last few years, the outlay in 1909 being the largest since the year 1901, which was exceptionally large. Not counting that year and excepting also the year 1904, which is smaller than 1907, the outlay for bridges in Douglas county has been in constantly increasing size, as the following table shows:

To this total add an estimated expenditure for 1910 as large as in 1909 and the total shows nearly \$200,000 expended on bridges in Douglas county in the last decade.
